Re: PLANS TO CLEAN CONTAMINENTS FROM THE FORMER AUTO WRECKING SITE AT 151 WOODWARD AVENUE, ALSO KNOWN AS 1904/1906 FLUSHING AVENUE, AND TO ESTABLISH AN ANIMAL SHELTER AT THIS SITE IN RIDGEWOOD, QUEENS

The Zoning and Land Use Review Committee of Community Board 5, Queens will conduct a Public Meeting regarding the plans of the N.Y. City Dept. of Health and Mental Hygiene and Animal Care and Control of New York City, Inc. to clean contaminants from the former auto wrecking and salvage site at 151 Woodward Avenue, also known as 1904/1906 Flushing Avenue, in Ridgewood, Queens (Block 3376; Lots 1 and 7), and establish an animal shelter for approximately 170 dogs and cats at this location. The contaminants at this site are primarily petroleum and metals related, caused by the use of this site since 1962 for auto wrecking and auto salvage.

At this public meeting representatives of Animal Care and Control of New York City, Inc. and their environmental consultant, AKRF, Inc., will explain the upcoming clean-up planned and the intended use of this site for an Animal Shelter.
