

Local Law 30 of 2017 improves access to City services for those with limited English ability by creating a centralized language access policy for New York City. Local Law 30 expands Executive Order 120 which mandates that all City agencies that provide direct public services create a language access implementation plan to ensure meaningful language access to their services. Below is the Department of Records and Information Services (DORIS) language access implementation plan.
