RULES:

- Artwork must be related to the theme: “HeARTwork Against Hate.”
- Participants must be between the ages of 10 and 18 and reside in New York City.
- All artwork must be original.
- All art forms are eligible, including drawing, collages, paintings, photography, sculpture, poetry, computer graphics, 3D Art, etc.
- Dimensions for visual arts must be no larger than 11 inches x 20 inches, and no smaller than 8.5 inches x 11 inches.
- **DEADLINE EXTENDED:** All submissions (including photos of all hard copy artwork) must be submitted electronically to OPHC@cityhall.nyc.gov by no later than 5 p.m. on **October 31, 2020**.
