YORK AVENUE TAXI STAND RULES AND REGULATIONS

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) wishes to take this opportunity to remind all medallion taxicab drivers of the rules and regulations governing the taxi stand on the east side of York Avenue between 78th and 79th streets.

As a mixed-use taxicab stand, this taxi stand allows both group rides to the Financial District (at a fare of \$3.50 per passenger) as well as rides to any destination mandated by the TLC. Passengers wishing to go to destinations other than the Financial District are charged the metered fare.

As required by both City law and TLC regulations, drivers are required to take passengers to any requested destination within the five boroughs of New York City, Westchester and Nassau Counties, and Newark International Airport.

Drivers who refuse service to passengers requesting destinations other than the Financial District will be subject to TLC enforcement action.
