## NYC Department of Veterans' Services To Distribute Food, Toys, and Gingerbread House Kits to Veteran Families at Winter Hero Holiday Event

## 30,000 meals will be packed for needy Veterans, toys, and gingerbread house kits will also be provided at large-scale event to honor those who served

**New York** – The New York City Department of Veterans' Services (DVS) hosted its annual Winter Hero holiday event today, handing out 30,000 meals, as well as dispensing toys and gingerbread house kits to Veterans and their families in need. The event took place from 10 am – 2 pm at the Claremont Neighborhood Center, 489 East 169th Street, in the Bronx.

"No Veteran should go hungry in our city or not be able to provide a happy holiday for their children. With the generous donation of our partners, we are making a dent in the higher rates of food insecurity experienced by those who served while also handing out toys so that they don't feel left out this holiday season. These Veterans served our city, and now it is our turn to serve them," said **DVS Commissioner James Hendon**.

DVS' partners in the event included Bookwell Travel, which supplied 30,000 meals for the event or 2,500 food bags for families, and 44,000 hand sanitizers, and 44,000 sanitizing wipe packages to weekly DVS food outreach efforts. The United States Marine Corps Toys for Tots provided toys for boys and girls, newborn to 16. NYC Service contributed toys for children through its Secret Snowflake partnership with American Airlines. Bloomberg Philanthropies donated Gingerbread House kits to provide the Veteran families. Claremont Neighborhood Center generously hosted the event.

"We are an online booking platform that puts feeding the hungry first. Coming together for our 5-year mission for not only veterans that are hungry and homeless, but every American that is facing food insecurity and homelessness," said **Bookwell Founder Brian Gates**. "Bookwell Travel was founded with a mission to fight the hunger crisis in America. Starting with homeless veterans, and active military living in poverty. Once and for all given homelessness and food insecurity the pink slip."
