

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NEW YORK CITY  
WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE  
RECOMMENDING WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD DESIGNATION  
OF A NEW OPERATOR CONSORTIUM  
FOR THE NEW YORK CITY ONE-STOP SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS**, in September 2002 the New York City Workforce Investment Board (“Board”) designated an operator consortium for the New York City One-Stop System comprised of the New York City Department of Employment (“DOE”), the New York City Human Resources Administration (“HRA”), and the New York State Department of Labor (“SDOL”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of New York is transferring all responsibility for Workforce Investment Act adult and dislocated worker programs from DOE and HRA to the New York City Department of Small Business Services (DSBS) for the purposes of establishing more direct linkages between workers and businesses, targeting workforce development programs to business needs, and connecting workforce development initiatives with DSBS’s other business and economic development initiatives; and

**WHEREAS**, the City University of New York (“CUNY”) has substantial experience and expertise with respect to workforce development policy and programs; now, therefore, be it,

**RESOLVED**, by the Executive Committee of the Board, as follows:

1. It is recommended that the Board designate a new operator consortium for the New York City One-Stop System comprised of DSBS, CUNY, and SDOL, with DSBS serving as the lead member of the consortium.
2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
