The NYSDOH Revised 2007 Filtration Avoidance Determination (FAD), Section 4.6, Stream management Program, requires the City to continue to provide technical assistance and conservation guidance to riparian landowners and convene an annual meeting of Riparian Buffer Working Group. The meeting was held on January 21, 2016 at DEP's Kingston office.

The City is also required to meet annually with county contracting partners to review progress made in the previous year within each program area (Stream Projects, CSBI, SMIP, Education/Outreach/Training, and LFHMP) and re-evaluate priorities as the basis for preparing new Action Plans for the coming year, especially after major flood events. The meeting was held on January 22, 2016 at the Kingston office.
