
The Land Acquisition Program (Section 4.2) requires consultation with NYSDOH, USEPA and NYSDEC on the adequacy of funding and the potential need for additional funding for the program. This information is included in the Administration annual report (Section 9), which is part of this submission, and will be discussed when we meet to review the Administration report. DEP has allocated all funding for the Land Acquisition Program as required by the Revised FAD.

Catskill Turbidity Control Program (Section 4.11) requires DEP to conduct an annual meeting to review elements of the Catskill Turbidity Control program by September 30 of each year. A scheduling conflict prevented the meeting from being held as required by the end of September. The meeting has been rescheduled for October 4, 2016 in the Kingston Office.

The Watershed Monitoring Program (Section 5.1) requires DEP participation in educational seminars. The 2016 NYC Watershed Science & Technical Conference was held at the Diamond Mills Hotel, Saugerties, NY on September 13, 2016. DEP was one of the sponsors and had staff members attending and presenting at the conference. This conference has become well known for its important focus on the NYC watershed.
