

**Regulatory Agenda
Of the New York City Department for the Aging**

Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2016

Pursuant to Section 1042 of the Charter of the City of New York, the New York City Department for the Aging (“DFTA”) hereby publishes its Regulatory Agenda for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2016. This Regulatory Agenda describes briefly the subject areas in which it is anticipated that rules may be promulgated during the fiscal year.

Under Local Law 9 of 2015, DFTA is authorized to promulgate rules in relation to regulating Social Adult Day Care (SADC) programs. DFTA anticipates that it may promulgate various rules that will assist the Agency in carrying out its responsibility as an investigatory and enforcement agency under the local law. Such rules may include the following subject matter areas, among others:

- Registration Requirements, including updated changes
- Civil Penalties, including, but not limited to violations of SADCs standards promulgated by the NYS Office for the Aging and for not properly registering with DFTA
- Enforcement and issuance of Notices of Violation as the Mayor-designated agency under Local Law 9 of 2015

The individuals and entities likely to be affected by the proposed rules include all NYC Social Adult Day Care programs and the general public interested in the administration of City government.
