

Project Background


- Little Zelda has agreed to be the maintenance partner

- Bike Corral with space for 8 bikes
- Remove 1 car parking spaces on west side of street
- Add two large planter pots
- Add flexible delineators
- Add parking lane stripe





Example: 5th Avenue and Park Place, Brooklyn
