Project Background

- Bike corrals are rows of CityRacks installed in the curbside lane of the street instead of on the sidewalk.
- Every bike corral needs a maintenance partner to keep the bike corral clear of snow and debris.
- DOT has installed 21 bike corrals city wide including one in CB 2.

- Cycling in Long Island City and the surrounding communities is popular
- Located adjacent to the Vernon Av bike facility
- Communita Café has agreed to maintain bike corral site



Proposed Improvements

- Bike Corral with four bike racks - space for 8 bicycles
- Add 2 planter pots
- Add 4 flexible delineators to protect racks and bikes
- Removes 1 car parking space on northwest side of street
- Increases bike parking in area for residents, shoppers, and merchants/employees
- Supports local business
- Keeps bicycles off of the sidewalk






