

2 Proposed Bike Corrals: Achilles Heel & Freehold Brooklyn

Program Background

- Row of bike racks installed in the street along the curb
- 45 bike corrals city wide
- 5 in CB 1
- Locations are determined through application process
- Site cleared of debris and snow, plantings maintained, and abandoned bicycles reported by maintenance partner

Broadway & Berry St
Installed: May 2013
Maintained by: Marlow & Sons

Physical Guidelines

- Curbside lane never used for travel
- Minimum of 15' away from fire hydrants or bus stops
- May not block crosswalks, driveways, utility covers




N 1st & Driggs St

Existing Conditions – Freehold Brooklyn



S 3rd St and Wythe Street shows existing bicycle parking demand.


Proposed Improvements – Freehold Brooklyn

- Bike corral with space for 8 bicycles
- 2 large planter pots
- Flexible delineators
- Add parking lane line
- Remove 1 parking space on north side of street




Project Map - Achilles Heel

- Achilles Heel requested bike corral
- Same owners of Marlow & Sons, who maintain a bike corral
- West St to undergo capital reconstruction starting fall 2015, so sidewalk cannot hold racks



Existing Conditions – Achilles Heel

- Bikes locked to sign posts show existing demand



Existing Conditions - Achilles Heel

- Planned tree pit prevents sidewalk racks from being installed



Proposed Improvements – Achilles Heel

- Bike corral with space for 8 bicycles
- 2 large planter pots
- Flexible delineators
- Remove 1 parking spaces on south side of street
