NYC DOT will implement protected bike lanes between Queens Blvd. and Grand Central Pkwy. Ser. Rd.:

- Add parking protected bike lanes on 62nd Dr., 63rd Rd., and Grand Central Pkwy. Ser. Rd.
- Remove one travel lane in each direction on 62nd Dr. from Junction Blvd. to 97th St., and from 99th St. to Yellowstone Blvd., and on Grand Central Pkwy. Ser. Rd. from 62nd Ave. to 63rd Rd.
- Add turning treatments at intersections to increase cyclist and pedestrian safety

Implementation begins May 2022
