Install standard and curbside bicycle lanes, shared lanes and a protected lane on:

East-West Routes:

- 23rd Ave., 19th St. to 43rd St.
- 36th Ave., Vernon Blvd. to 29th St.

North-South Routes:

Ditmars-Steinway to Astoria

- 43rd St. northbound from Northern Blvd. to 20th Ave.
- 42nd St. southbound from 20th Ave. to 23rd Ave.
- 44th St. southbound from Astoria Blvd S. to Northern Blvd.
- Sound Ave. southbound from 23rd Ave. to Astoria Blvd N.
- 43rd St. Bridge from Astoria Blvd. N to Astoria Blvd S.
- Astoria Blvd S. eastbound from 43rd St. to 44th St
- Crescent St. northbound from Hoyt Ave. N. to 20th Ave.
- 24th St. southbound from 20th Ave. to Hoyt Ave N.

Long Island City to Astoria

- 22nd St. southbound from Queens Plaza S. to 36th Ave.
- 23rd St. northbound from Queens Plaza S. to 36th Ave.

Connections to Honeywell St. Bridge

- 39th Ave. eastbound from Crescent St. to Northern Blvd.
- 38th Ave. from Crescent St. to 32nd St.
- 32nd St. northbound from 39th Ave. to 38th Ave.
