Safety and Accessibility Improvements

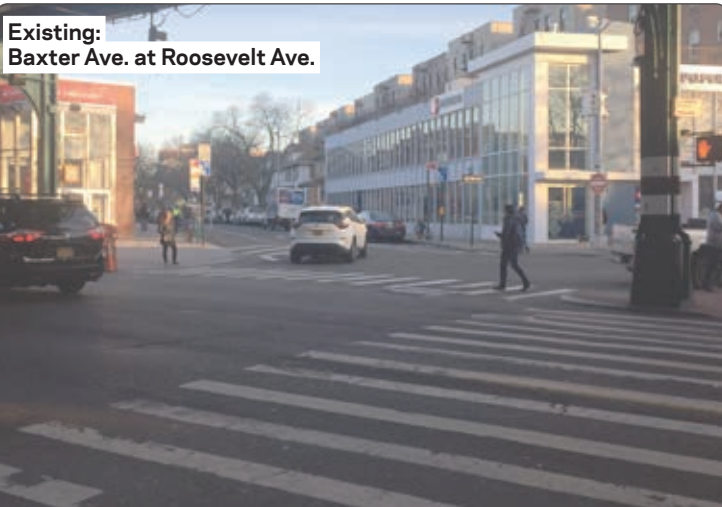
Increase Pedestrian Visibility

Slower, Safer Turns

NYC DOT will implement pedestrian improvements on Baxter Ave. from Roosevelt Ave. to 82nd St.:

- Build concrete curb extension at Roosevelt Ave.
- Restrict vehicle turns from Roosevelt Ave. to Gleane St.
- Restrict left turn from Baxter Ave. to Roosevelt Ave.
- Install a painted pedestrian curb extension at 83rd St. with a new crosswalk and pedestrian ramps
- Install a stop sign and crosswalk at 82nd St.

Implementation will begin in Spring/Summer 2021
