

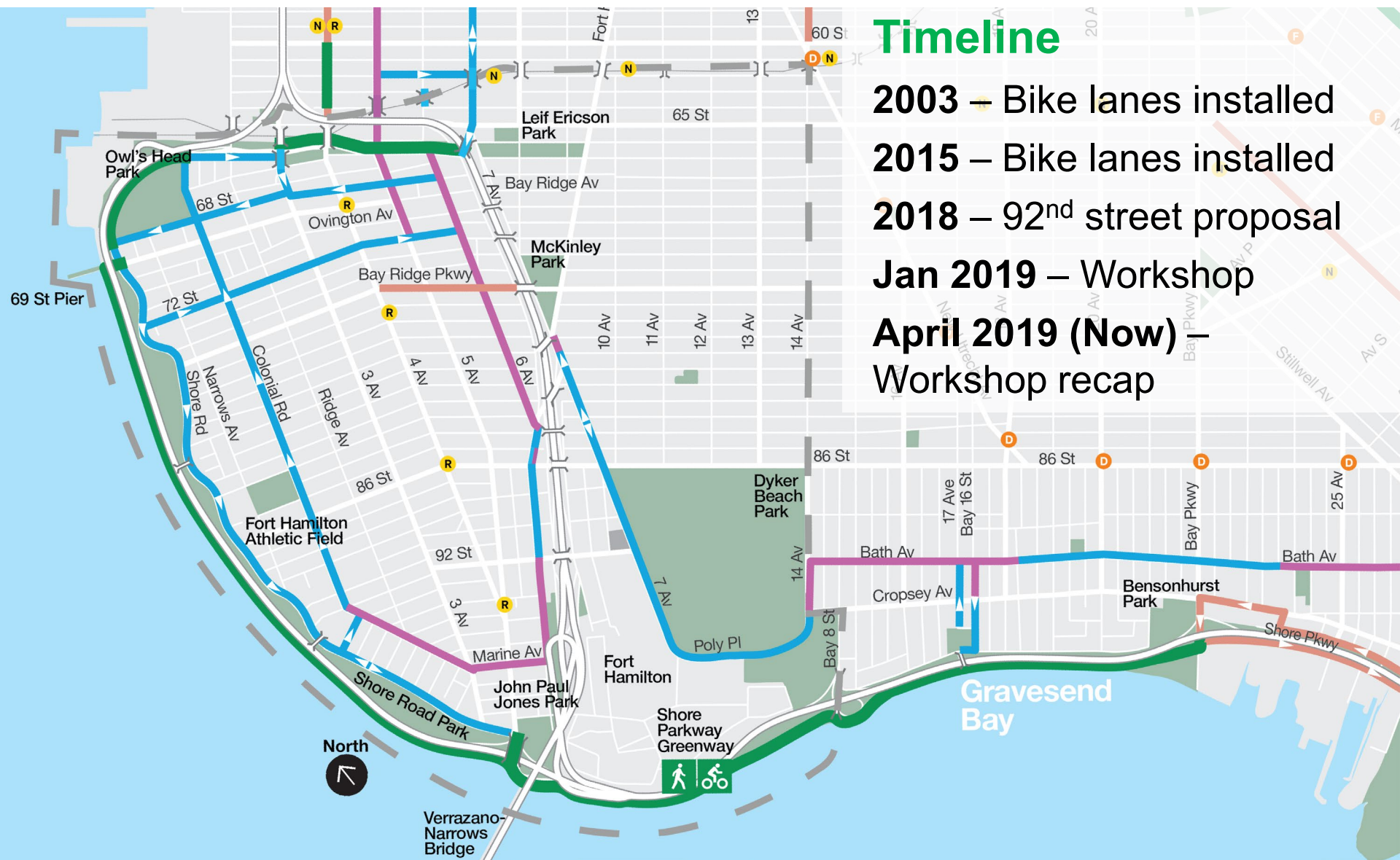

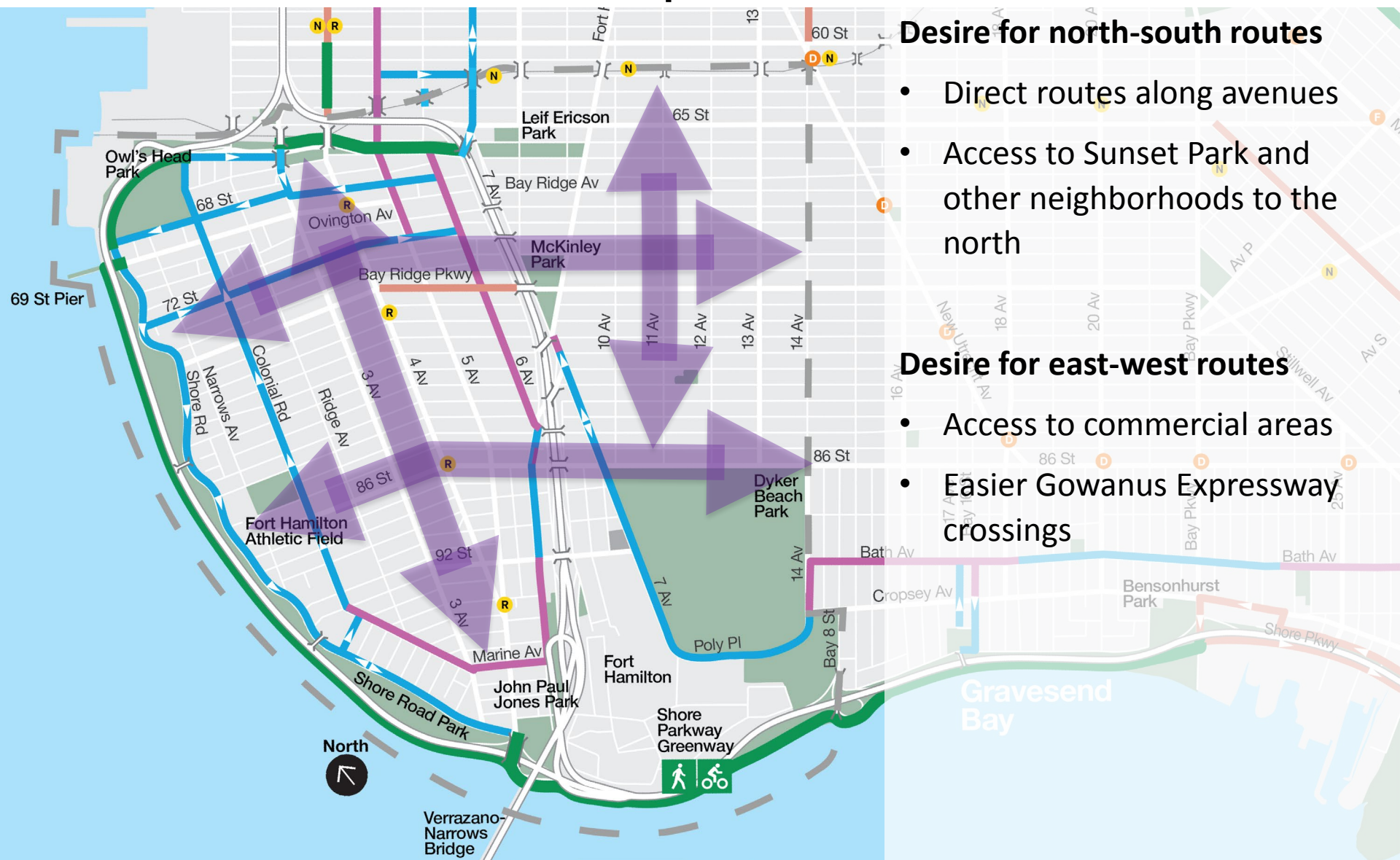
## Community Concerns
