NYC DOT will implement safety improvements, including painted and concrete median tip extensions and pedestrian ramp upgrades along Jamaica Ave. in Queens:

- Construct painted median tip extensions at 9 intersections on Jamaica Ave.
- Construct concrete median tip extensions on Jamaica Ave. at Springfield Blvd. and 212th St.
- Restrict the Eastbound left turn from Jamaica Ave. to Springfield Blvd.
- Upgrade pedestrian ramps as needed
- Upgrade roadway markings to current NYC DOT standard

Implementation begins in April
