


Outdoor Learning-Streets Guidelines for Schools



T-In Intersections

- If a school is located at the bottom of a T intersection and the intersecting street leads into the pedestrian street, the school must place and staff barricades at the end of the block leading to the T. Otherwise, vehicles could be trapped at the entrance to the pedestrian street.
- All parking is maintained on side streets

T-Away Intersections

- If a school is located at the bottom of a T intersection and the intersecting street leads away from the pedestrian street, barricades must be sited at the T intersection to ensure vehicles do not attempt to access the side street from OL-S, thereby disrupting classes
- All parking is maintained on side streets
