

PROJECT LOCATION

- Multi-leg intersection with residential land use
- Moore Catholic High School and PS 60, The Alice Austin School 3 blocks north of intersection
- S62, S92 and X11 buses on Victory Blvd
- NYCT request for bus stop improvements



SAFETY DATA

- 7 injuries (2012-16)
 - 3 pedestrian, 4 motor vehicle
- 100% of pedestrians were hit when crossing with the signal
- Victory Blvd is a Vision Zero Priority Corridor



EXISTING CONDITIONS & ISSUES

Long Crossing Distances




Bus riders with no safe place to wait




Lack of clear markings, lane designations



PROPOSAL



Eliminate existing channelization and restore parking on Victory Blvd (+ 9 spaces)




Construct concrete sidewalk / bus stop

Construct concrete splitter island and add lane designations for westbound vehicles on Victory Blvd



PROPOSAL DETAILS



Narrowed proposed concrete island, based on community feedback

Maintain existing "curb line" for new bus stop

Maintain space for vehicles continuing straight on WB Victory Blvd to maneuver safely around vehicles waiting to turn to SB Arlene St

BENEFITS OF PROPOSAL

- Shortens crossing distances for pedestrians
- New sidewalk provides safe place to wait for transit riders and makes bus stop safe and accessible
- Upgraded markings clarify vehicle movements and restore parking spaces on Victory Blvd
