JOB DESCRIPTION

The Agency Attorney LII will conduct investigations of alleged Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) violations. Conduct interviews of complainants, respondents, and witnesses. Gather relevant documents and prepare written summaries of investigations and recommendations. Prepare administrative closing memos to the Assistant Commissioner of EEO, including referrals to appropriate Bureaus for action. Research legal issues relating to EEO Law. Conduct EEO Compliance Inspections for Fire Department facilities. Conduct EEO training for FDNY employees, EEO Counselors, and FDNY units as needed. Perform other related work as may be designated by the Assistant Commissioner/Deputy Director of EEO.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Admission to the New York State Bar; and either "2" or "3" below.
2. One year of satisfactory United States legal experience subsequent to admission to any state bar; or
3. Six months of satisfactory service as an Agency Attorney Interne.

Incumbents must remain Members of the New York State Bar in good standing for the duration of this employment.

Note: In addition to meeting the minimum Qualification Requirements: To be assigned to AL III candidates must have two years of experience in Assignment Levels I and/or II or three years of comparable legal experience subsequent to admission to the bar, in the areas of law related to the assignment.

PREFERRED SKILLS:

Experienced trainer or public speaker. Proficiency in Microsoft Office Word, Excel, and Powerpoint. A Motor Vehicle Driver's License valid in the State of New York. The ability to drive within the five boroughs.
