NEW LIVERY STAND LAUNCHED AT ST. GEORGE FERRY TERMINAL

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) in coordination with the Department of Transportation (DOT) and the Economic Development Corporation (EDC) will launch a dedicated livery stand on September 7 at the St. George Ferry Terminal in Staten Island. This stand will be operated exclusively by United Car Service.

HOW IT WORKS

- **Only United Car Service cars can pick-up and drop-off at the new stand.**
- ***Drivers for other car services/livery bases must pick-up passengers on Richmond Terrace. They can no longer pick-up passengers at the ferry terminal.***
- ***However, drivers for other car services/livery bases can continue to drop-off passengers at the Kiss and Ride Lot.***
- ***NYPD and TLC Enforcement will enforce against drivers from other car service/livery bases who attempt to pick-up at the ferry terminal.***
- ***Passengers are free to pre-arrange pick-ups with the licensed car service/livery base of their choice on Richmond Terrace.***
