**TLC ANNOUNCES BEAVER STREET AND STATEN ISLAND FACILITY
CLOSURES; LONG ISLAND CITY AND WOODSIDE FACILITIES TO
STAY OPEN**

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) wishes to alert its licensees that the TLC's 33 Beaver Street facility will remain closed tomorrow November 1, 2012. The TLC's Long Island City and Woodside facilities will be open for normal services. Due to storm related damage the TLC's Staten Island facility will be closed until further notice.

If you had a scheduled Office of Administrative Trials and Hearings (OATH) hearing at 33 Beaver Street or an application appointment scheduled at Staten Island, it will be rescheduled as follows:

33 Beaver Street:

If you were scheduled for a hearing at 33 Beaver Street, you will receive a letter in the mail from OATH with a new date for your hearing.

Staten Island Licensing Facility:

Vehicle owners with appointments for our Staten Island facility will be contacted to arrange for a new appointment date and time.
