

LICENSEES CAN NOW PLEAD GUILTY TO AND PAY SUMMONSES ON-LINE!

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) is pleased to announce that it can now offer anyone who has received a TLC issued summons the convenience of both pleading guilty to and making an on-line payment for the summons they have received. The TLC's on-line transaction system which, prior to this enhancement only allowed existing licensees to make their license renewal payment on-line, has been expanded to enable anyone who has received a TLC issued summons to plead guilty to and pay that summons on-line, provided that no court appearance is required. (*Licensee must carefully check the summons to confirm that no appearance is required!*) In addition, if you have an open summons for which a guilty verdict has been rendered but you have not yet paid the fine amount due, you can now pay the balance due on that summons on-line as well.

You may now both plead guilty to and pay the fine amount on-line for a summons that was previously payable by mail. The on-line system will allow you to search for a specific summons or for all of your outstanding summonses.
